LIFESLED has resulted from 17 years of research & development by Hawaii's finest watermen operating in extreme North Shore conditions.



Features:

- LIFESLED is highly maneuverable. It barely affects low speed motoring while increasing the overall stability of the craft. There is no chance of windmilling, dumping of victim.
- The Bullet nose allows 45° fish-tail pivot off the PWC transom.
- It's 70/30 rails allow sufficient tracking for stability while still allowing the driver to "break loose" for quick turns.
- Inexpensive, replaceable noseguard protects the nose of the sled and the PWC transom.
- Overall size is sufficient for two adults yet still highly maneuverable. Weighs only 42 lbs and is **robustly** reinforced
- Swallow-tail design enables easy victim centering when mounting in the water.
- Hook-up design allows the sled to be folded over the PWC when not in use.
- Composite construction yields high buoyancy with extreme strength-to-weight ratio.
